Duties and responsibilities

Some of the duties and responsibilities associated with this role include:

- Perform service and PPM checks, tests and inspections in accordance with industry standards and hospital requirements.
- Identify and document items which have changed since previous inspections.
- Identify and report electrical faults.
- Identify and report changes in the condition of plant and/or plant rooms.
- Report any major issues that may/will affect medical gas supply.
- Submitting job summary and maintenance reports.
- Maintaining van stocks.
- Undertake a full range of servicing and reactive maintenance tasks.

Experience required

To be considered for this role you will have an engineering background, with a minimum of 2 years as a Service Engineer, or time-served apprenticeship (preferably multiskilled). Competent Person (MGPS) status will be an advantage.

A knowledge of servicing medical gas systems, compressor maintenance and repairs, and knowledge of compressors, vacuum pumps, gas manifolds, gas outlets, alarms and pressure equipment will be desired, but not essential.
