Regular maintenance in accordance with HTM 02-01 and as specified by the Trust to medical gas pipeline systems including terminal units, however mounted, alarm systems associated with the medical gas systems, visible medical gas pipelines and their means of isolation, manifolds, including emergency reserve and stand-by units, medical / surgical air compressors and vacuum plant and anaesthetic gas scavenging systems (AGSS).
