- Ensuring sites are clean and tidy, safe and secure.

Experience required

Previous practical experience in an installation environment where the quality, reliability and performance of the installed systems are of paramount importance is

preferred. Previous medical gases pipeline systems experience is also preferred but training will be provided for those whose skill-set might not meet with our precise requirements and/or whose experience might have been gained in other industry settings.
